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Tom Hiddleston is playing Loki in the highly anticipating comic book adaptation THOR directed by Kenneth Branagh. A newcomer dons the villainous mantle of Loki, Thor's brother..." - How do you make a character like this sympathetic to the audience? "Ken encouraged me to show his vulnerability; that he's actually Thor's younger brother, and he wants his father's love just as much as the next man. Thor seems to get it without question. And Loki is out in the cold on his own. I hope that's something that people can understand." - Does he love his brother Thor? Or is he just pretending for Odin's sake? "I like to think that Loki's such a good liar that you can't tell. I didn't want to do any
